Three more stormy days have succeeded once more in disrupting air transportation. Have one of our ships down at San Diego and the westbound is snarled in at Douglas. However that's considerable better than having search parties out looking for them. Looks like more showers this afternoon.
The merger with Western Air is assured - approximately 87% of the Aero Corp common stock having been deposited for exchange up to noon yesterday. By the time stock in the mail has come in there will have been over 90% deposited, probably. Expect to transfer air line operation over ~~the~~ Western Air before the first, which will take that off my hands. The next few weeks will require considerable work towards joining the two organizations for the greatest economy and least friction and disturbance. We expect to make this ship and motor overhaul base for all Western Air, Midcontinent, West Coast and Standard airline equipment. This will require the complete overhaul of two
